Game Ball

The Rawlings R1NCAA baseball has been selected as the official baseball for all games in the three National Collegiate Championship tournaments. Each team must furnish its own practice balls.

Official Travel Party and Squad Size

Each team is limited to 24 eligible players in uniform to be designated and submitted at the pre-tournament meeting. No changes may be made in a team roster for any reason. Each team will be permitted a maximum of 34 people in the dugout, including 24 eligible players in uniform, eight others

in uniform (coaching staff included) and two other non-uniformed personnel who have regularly performed these functions during the season. Non uniformed personnel may not participate in pre-game warm-ups or game type functions.

Rules

NCAA Baseball Rules will be followed. Per NCAA Bylaw 17.33, member institutions shall conduct all of their intercollegiate competition in accordance with the playing rules of the Association in all sports for which the NCAA develops playing rules.

Uniform/Home Team Assignments

Once a team enters the playing area, it must be in full pre-game or regular game uniforms. These uniforms must be worn during warm-ups, batting practice, infield practice and competition. The home team will be in the third base dugout, take infield practice first and wear white uniforms if team has white uniforms. The visiting team will be in the first base dugout, take infield after home team, and wear a contrasting uniform color. Jim Givens will resolve any conflict in selection of uniforms. The highest seeded team (one being the highest) shall be designated as the home team.

Locker Rooms

All teams will be assigned locker rooms in the Physical Activities Center. Laundry services are available in the Physical Activities Center and this must be arranged with the Tournament Director.

Media Personnel

The NCAA shall control the issuance of media credentials for each of its championships. Subject to limitations of space, media credentials shall be assigned in accordance with the following priorities: (1) campus media of each participating and host institution, (2) certified media from the immediate locale of the championship or the immediate locale of the competing teams, and (3) other certified media.
