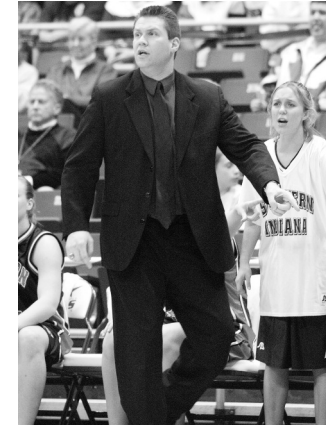

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## Head Coach/Director

### Rick Stein



Rick Stein, a 1992 USI graduate with a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration is in his tenth season at the helm of the University of Southern Indiana Women's basketball program. In 19 seasons with the USI Women's basketball team, eight as an assistant and ten as head coach, Stein has been a part of 350 Eagle victories, eight NCAA II tournament appearances, four regular season GLVC Titles, and a record three GLVC Tournament Championships. Stein has been a part of 70 percent of USI's all-time victories.

## Assistant Coach

### Randa Dallas



Former USI student athlete Randa Galling is in her eleventh season as an assistant coach. Galling started her career at Central High School. She served as Central's first ever girl's head coach of the freshman squad. During her playing days at USI, Galling, a native of Evansville, Indiana, was a member of the 1997 NCAA Division II Tournament Finalist team, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998 teams which appeared in the NCAA II Tournament, and the 1995, 1997, and 1998 Great Lakes Valley Conference Championship teams. The Eagles were a dominating 100-16 (.862) during Galling's four years as a player, including an amazing 67-9 (.881) in the GLVC.

## Assistant Coach

### Michelle Irwin/Wagner



Michelle Irwin enters her fourth season with the USI women's basketball program. She will assist in all aspects of the USI women's basketball program. Irwin comes to USI from Ashland University, where she was a graduate assistant since 2004. She helped the Ashland Eagles to an NCAA II Tournament appearance, two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference South Division titles, and two 20-win seasons.

Irwin played for USI Head Coach Rick Stein from 1999-02 and was part of the Screaming Eagles' back-to-back GLVC Tournament championship teams. USI amassed a 70-22 mark, 43-17 in the GLVC, during Irwin's three seasons in a USI uniform. The Eagles also appeared in the NCAA II Tournament twice.

## Coaching Staff

Coach Stein has recruited former and current Lady Eagle Players who are energetic and experienced coaches and will teach and demonstrate the fundamentals of the game.

## What to Bring?

**OVERNIGHTERS:** Each camper should bring a week's supply of socks, shorts, T-shirts, basketball shoes, towels, soap, toothbrush, **bedding (or sleeping bag)**, swimsuit, and other camp clothing, as needed.

**COMMUTERS:** Should bring change of socks, T-shirt, shorts.

## Housing For Overnight Campers

The USI basketball camp offers one of the best housing arrangements in the country. Campers reside in furnished, air-conditioned two bedroom dorms with four campers to a unit. **Campers will be separated by age groups;** room-mate preferences will be honored when possible. **Linens are not furnished.**

Housing will be closely monitored by camp staff who will be staying in the dorm area, and is patrolled by USI Campus Security.

## Supervision

The camp will be supervised by USI coaches and counselors. The ratio will be one staff member for every 10 to 12 campers. Rules established by the directors must be respected. Campers will be responsible for any damage they cause to their rooms or other campus property. Camp officials try to treat all our young ladies fairly and responsibly.

## What the Fee Includes

The camp fee includes a camp T-shirt, individual fundamental periods each day, guest lectures, team play, and insurance on each camper. **The June 5 skills camps and the team camp do not include camp T-shirt.**

## Meals

For the June 20-23 camps, overnight campers will be provided breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Commuters will receive lunch and dinner. No meals will be provided for the June 5 and the June 14-17 camps and the June 25-27 camps.

## Camp Insurance/Physicals

The USI Girls Basketball Camp provides secondary accident/medical insurance. No physical is required. Each camper must have a completed parental consent form. The form is located on the back of the Registration Form.
